

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

She keeps herself busy knocking down cobwebs, dusting the woolly whale skeletons, and polishing the flesh-eating seaweed exhibits—but the museum is falling into disrepair.

Kess yearns to follow in her parents' footsteps and explore the bog, despite Shrunken Jim's dire stories about the witches and dangerous mega fauna that live there. So when Lilou, a girl from town, knocks on the door of the museum with both a strange mystery to solve and an opportunity for friendship (and maybe something more), Kess dismisses Shrunken Jim's warnings and crosses the watchfires to venture deep into the bog where the mega fauna may lie. Neither girl expects the dark secrets in wait for them, or the intersecting mysteries that will ultimately help Kess understand why she's never quite felt whole—and why she's so drawn to the cursed creatures of Eelgrass Bog.

One day, everything was exactly as it was supposed to be. And the next, the closest thing Abby ever had to a sister, Noreen, was just... gone.





MARI AND THE CURSE OF EL COCODRILO



WILDSEED WITCH: book 1




ANZU AND THE REALM OF DARKNESS


NIGHT OF THE LIVING QUEERS


THE DEVOURING WOLF: book 1 by Natalie C. Parker Razorbill, August 2022



Her overbearing mother insists she be the "perfect" Chinese American daughter—which means suppressing her ghost-speaking powers—and she keeps getting into fights with Zacharias Coleson, the local golden boy whose smirk makes her want to set things on fire. Then she stumbles across Zach's dead body in the woods. He's even more infuriating as a ghost, but Cara's the only one who can see him—and save him.

Agreeing to resurrect him puts her at odds with her mother, draws her into a dangerous liminal world of monsters and magic—and worse, leaves her stuck with Zach. Yet as she and Zach grow closer, forced to depend on each other to survive, Cara finds the most terrifying thing is that she might not hate him so much after all. Maybe this is why her mother warned her about ghosts.

The older sister, the ambitious and uncompromising Clara, has a rule against dating that the younger sister Molly, a vivacious former starlet of the Yiddish stage, is intent on breaking. In fact, Molly's burgeoning romance with NYU freshman Anat is just about the worst-kept secret in the neighborhood. Even their box-office attendant, the reluctant-medium Boaz, is in on it.

But when a stolen kiss stirs the dead, Anat vanishes not just from her dorm, but from the memories of everyone she's ever known. To find Anat, the sisters and Boaz must work together to face down old ghosts and older demons from the depths of Manhattan's monstrous underworld. If they fail, they too will disappear.

Drawing on New York City history and Jewish folklore, *The Night Owls* marries the traditional elements of Isaac Bashevis Singer stories with the tone of Holly Black.


