
"They're not going to catch us," Dan Aykroyd as Elwood Blues tells his brother Jake, played by John Belushi. "We're on a mission from God." UTTER, EARTH: Advice on Living in a More-than-Human World by Isaac Yuen

A light, literary take on an animal book for grown-ups, a tongue-incheek self-help column with lessons drawn from nature, a sort of hitch-hiker's guide to the more-than-human world—Isaac Yuen's *Utter, Earth* is a celebration, through wordplay and earthplay, of our planet's riotous wonders.

For animal lovers and readers of Brian Doyle, Aimee Nezhukumatathil, and Amy Leach, each essay of this one-of-a-kind collection combines joyous language, whimsical tangents, and scientific findings to remind us of and reconnect us with those to whom we are inextricably bound. Highlighting life that once was, still is, and all that we stand to lose, this living and lively mini encyclopedia (complete with glossary) shines the spotlight on the motley, fantastical, and astonishing denizens with whom we share this planet.


